This rule **WON'T** protect you from utility shut off, it's not an excuse to stop paying your bills. Stop in for more information.

<u>Conservation Improvement Program:</u> The City of Round Lake offers a rebate program to support our conservation efforts. We have an appliance rebate program that is available to all utility customers. To qualify for the rebate the appliance must be an **ENERGY STAR** appliance on the list of qualifying appliances. You need to bring the <u>YELLOW STICKER</u> from the appliance and <u>the receipt</u> (must be purchased in 2019 to qualify for this year's program) to City Hall and fill out a special form. Once I have all of this information, we will be giving the rebate on your December bill. REMEMBER — IT MUST BE PURCHASED IN 2019 TO QUALIFY!

<u>Heating Season</u>: The heating season is fast approaching! Please make sure your furnace and/or heaters are in working order. Now is a good time to make any repairs or replacements, if necessary, before the cold weather really sets in.

<u>Safety for our kids:</u> We have been getting a lot of complaints about people speeding in town lately. The intersection of Harrison St and 4th Avenue is especially dangerous. The stop signs are there to serve a purpose and there is no logical reason to be going over a responsible speed in town. Please be mindful of the possibility that there are children on the road, either walking or riding their bikes. We have even had a near accident with a lawnmower recently. 


