Regulation of Winter Parking

An Ordinance Regulating Parking Between the Months of October and April.

The City Council of The City of Round Lake, Nobles County, Minnesota  
Does Ordain:

Parking Prohibition:

Between the first of October and the last day of April, after the accumulation of any snowfall, no owner or operator of any vehicle shall park or allow such vehicle to stand, on any street until snow removal has been completed.

Removal:

Any vehicle which shall be left parked or standing in violation of this ordinance may be summarily removed without notice to the owner or operator by city employees of the City of Round Lake, or persons employed or designated by them, and stored in any appropriate place. All necessary costs and expenses of towing, removing and storage of such vehicle shall be first paid to the impound facility by the person claiming the vehicle before the release of the same.


Definitions:

- A. Vehicle shall mean every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway.
- B. Street shall mean any street, avenue, place, drive or any other public way in the City of Round Lake.

Effective Date:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
